

Learning and Skills Teacher - Level 5



This advanced apprenticeship is an ideal qualification for those who already hold a Level 3 qualification and are looking to progress in their careers. It develops the pedagogical skills needed to inspire and educate adult learners in a range of institutions. Ideal for Practice Education Facilitators.

Teaching can be delivered at a range of levels including essential skills generally up to Level 3 including, academic, vocational and technical education, some teachers may deliver subjects up to post-graduate level; it will also cover a broad range of both academic and technical subject/sector areas.

The broad purpose of the occupation is to ensure that students achieve the best possible knowledge, skills and behaviours. Learning and Skills Teachers do this by planning and delivering teaching that is current, comprehensive and challenging, and that inspires students to engage, progress and achieve their full potential.

In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with other Teachers and FES professionals and students of different ages, abilities, backgrounds and ambitions. Teachers who are specialists in a particular technical or vocational subject, sector or occupation will typically maintain close working relationships with others working in their industry/sector and keep their own knowledge and skills up to date.



Delivery:

- Monthly workshops
- Module-Specific Seminars (online)
- Regular 1:1 reviews with a designated Coach
- Dedicated e-portfolio system
- Access to a large range of learning resources and CPD
- Full End Point Assessment preparation and support

Duration: The typical duration of this programme is 18 months. You must also allow for an additional 3 months EPA period.

Entry Requirements: Apprentices must be in a role that supports the gathering of evidence for the apprenticeship standards.

End Point Assessment: The EPA comprises varied assessments including professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence and a workplace observation with questions.

Some of the skills an apprentice will learn



- **Duty 1** Promote a passion for learning and set high expectations of all students and support their personal and skills development
- **Duty 2** Maintain a focus on outcomes, for all students, so that they recognise the value of their learning and the future opportunities available to them
- **Duty 3** Demonstrate, maintain and evidence excellent pedagogy, subject, curriculum and industry knowledge and practice
- **Duty 4** Plan, deliver and evaluate effective evidence-informed teaching using assessment, relevant systems and safe use of technology to support learning
- **Duty 5** Work in a manner that values diversity, and actively promote equality of opportunity and inclusion by responding to the needs of all students
- **Duty 6** Model professional relationships with students, colleagues and stakeholders that support the highest quality education and training
- **Duty 7** Work within professional boundaries, legal and ethical standards to set clear expectations for engaging in learning for all students
- **Duty 8** Undertake relevant roles and duties and model sustainable practices, having regard to professional standards, demonstrating resilience and adaptability when dealing with challenge and change
- **Duty 9** Support students with their next steps for progression and learning by providing appropriate information, advice, and guidance
